## entry requirements

<b>Who can enter?</b>	This competition is at advanced level and therefore individuals should be studying towards their level 3 qualification (NVQ/SVQ) in nail technology Those who can enter will be over the age of 16 and currently training to be nail technicians.
<b>Individual and/or team event?</b>	Individual
<b>What type of competition 'live' or 'mixed'</b>	This competition is 'live'.
<b>How many competitors can enter?</b>	1 competitor for the intermediate competition per organisation.
<b>Competition structure</b>	
<b>Step 1</b>	Register for this competition at <a href="http://www.worldskillsuk.org">www.worldskillsuk.org</a> by <b>28<sup>th</sup> February 08</b>
<b>Step 2</b>	In March 08 competitors will be allocated to heats across the country, these are usually during May and June 08.
<b>Step 3</b>	Competitors who have achieved the highest marks across all heats will be invited to the UK final

## competition description

Throughout the competition a floor judge will be observing their desk set up and working practices. Competitors will also be given marks for professional appearance and attitude throughout the competition. All logos or distinguishing badges on uniforms must be covered.

- Competitors must finish the competition within the two and a half hours specified
- All competitors must supply their own equipment, tools and products and client record card.
- No drills allowed
- All competitors must paint their models right hand with two coats of crème red polish
- No base or top coats are permitted on either hand
- The models left hand after nail enhancements have been applied will be left to a buffed finish
- Polish on the underside of the nails is not permitted
- Any manufacturer's brand is permitted
- Nails may be any length or shape best suited to the model's hands
- Competitors will be judged on performance during the competition as well as the final result
- Competitors must stay at their workstation for the full 2 ½ period so as not to disturb other competitors. At the end of the competition they will have a ten-minute period to clear their workstation of all belongings and leave the competition area.

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- Each competitor will be given a number which must be clearly displayed at all times on their workstation and also on their models right hand
- Models' hands will be inspected prior to the start
- Strictly no smoking or eating during the competition although models will be allowed a bottle of water

Competitors must demonstrate a commercially acceptable nail enhancement treatment using any of the two nail products:

- Liquid and Powder
- UV Gel

Competitors may in this competition use sculpting forms or tip and overlay as the treatment. They must indicate on their application form which products they will use.

The judges will want to see good preparation of the natural nail as well as safe techniques used during the competition. This also includes reviewing and altering where necessary the client consultation, preparation of client, an effective treatment along with after/homecare and completion of the record card within the stipulated time.

Competitors must use a crème red polish to paint the right hand whilst buffing the left hand to a high shine.

The organisers will provide a table two chairs and a lamp for each competitor.

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## Marking and assessment

Assessment methods will be by observation during the competition and examination of the finished product at the end.

The criteria for assessment and the allocation of maximum marks for each criterion are as set out on the attached marking schedule forms.

There are 100 marks available as follows:

Health and Safety, and Consultation	10
Nail enhancement treatment	90

The marking sheets to be used are attached.

After the marking of the finished product, the results will be brought together and moderated. Once any outstanding issues have been resolved, winners will be announced and certificates presented.

## judging

A panel of judges have been drawn from industry, further education, higher education and training providers. The judges' decisions will be independently moderated and quality assured before being confirmed.



## rules

The organisers will provide a table, two chairs and a lamp for each competitor.

Conduct for competitors during live competitions:

- Competitors must finish the competition within the 2 ½ hours specified
- All competitors must supply their own equipment, tools and products
- Any manufacturer's brand is permitted
- Competitors must stay at their workstation they will have a ten-minute period to clear their workstation of all belongings and leave the competition area.
- Each competitor will be given a number which must be clearly displayed at all times on their workstation and also on their models right hand
- Strictly no smoking or eating during the competition although models will be allowed a bottle of water
- Competitors are expected to dress appropriately through the competition
- Competitors who arrive late will not be allowed into the competition and will be disqualified
- Competitors will start and finish as instructed by the judges
- During the competition competitors should not disturb other students or talk to members of the public
- Any competitor wishing to leave the area during the competition must seek permission of the floor judge
- If there is an emergency of any sort the competitors must act according to the instruction of the judges
- Competitors who break or damage their own equipment during the competition will not receive any extra time
- Where a competitor is deemed to be working in an unsafe manner they will be stopped and not permitted to continue unless willing to follow the judges' directions

Competitors will be required to bring their own models who must not be contra-indicated to the treatments they will be performing. They must also have experience of treatments being performed.

- The model should have healthy natural nails with no distinguishing marks
- Models cannot leave the competition area until they have been judged by ALL judges
- They should not be wearing any distinguishable jewellery except a wedding band.
- All of models' nails should be clean and free of any base coat or polish.
- Models' hands will be inspected prior to the start of the competition
- All models will be required to attend the presentation ceremony
- Models must be over the age of 16
- It is the responsibility of the model to ensure they are seen by all judges
- It is the models' responsibility to ensure their number stays on their right hand whilst being judged.

<b>Step 1</b>	Register interest
	Receive username and password via email

<b>Step 2</b>	Select competitions to enter
<b>Step 3</b>	Enter competitions & confirm competitors – enter by 28 <sup>th</sup> February 2008
	Receive receipt after entering competitions
<b>Step 4</b>	Competitors are allocated to heats (live competitions only)
	Competitors entering 'live' competitions will receive confirmation during March 2008
<b>Step 5</b>	Competitors will compete within their heat. The highest scoring competitors from all heats are selected to participate in the national final.
<b>Step 6</b>	All competitors will receive either certificates of participation or winning certificates.
<b>If competitors are unable to attend competitions they must cancel their entry by 11<sup>th</sup> April 2008 to prevent cancellation charges (see competition rules for further details)</b>
