Course overview

The WorldSkills UK Beauty Therapy competition focuses on the role and tasks of a beauty therapist. Competitors carry out a range of treatments which reflect both current and traditional beauty therapy treatments. The competitors will be expected to demonstrate their skills in some of the following: warm waxing, manicure and facial plus make-up and consultation, body faradic treatment, full body massage and facial galvanic treatment. The students will have to do this in a timed situation and so will be under the pressure of the clock as well as the competition from their peers.
