Use of logo

The WorldSkills UK logo is to be used on assets that represent the parent organisation.

The logo should always be reproduced from original artwork. Never alter, redraw or recreate the logo in any way.

Logo variants

The logo is to be reproduced in full colour. Where this is not possible a mono black or white version is available.

Exclusion zone

The logo should always be surrounded by an area of clear space, free from other graphic elements. The minimum clear space around the logo should be equal to the width of the letter 'w' in the logo.

Minimum size

The minimum size is the smallest size at which the logo can be reproduced. It is not a recommended size and should only be used when space is very limited.
