LEARNING OUTCOMES – STUDENTS WILL:

- **UNDERSTAND WHAT WORLDSKILLS UK LIVE IS**
- **UNDERSTAND WHY LEARNING ABOUT CAREERS, SKILLS AND STUDY IS IMPORTANT**
- **LEARN HOW TO GET THE MOST FROM THEIR VISIT TO WORLDSKILLS UK LIVE**

SLIDE NUMBER	TIMINGS	KEY TEACHING POINTS
1	1 minute	Explain that in this session students are going to find out about WorldSkills UK LIVE in preparation for their visit.
2	3 minutes	This slide highlights the opportunity that visiting WorldSkills UK LIVE will bring - read through the bullet points.
3	4 minutes	Play the WorldSkills UK LIVE video.
4	1 minute	Highlight how attending WorldSkills UK LIVE is a great opportunity for students to start preparing themselves for their future.
5	2 minutes	Read the key points of the slide that talk about the changing world of careers and study options.
6	3 minutes	Explain how there are so many options for students to think about, and it's a great time for them to be thinking ahead. Information is key, the more they understand about the range of careers available, skills and learning options, the better able they are to make the good choices.
7	2 minutes	Students don't have to decide today what career they want, and indeed they may change their minds many times. But what is crucial is understanding that, to have a successful career they will need to start developing the skills employers want so that the options open up to them. Developing themselves into young professionals and honing their work and life skills is key.
8	4 minutes	Students can make the most of WorldSkills UK LIVE by being prepared before they go. Showing up at WorldSkills UK LIVE with some ideas, questions and a plan will help them have a great experience and ensure they get the most from the day.

PLENARY ACTIONS:

Careers Cloud
