IF YOU DON'T KNOW WHAT CAREERS OR COMPANIES YOU ARE INTERESTED IN, THAT IS OK. WORLD SKILLS UK LIVE CAN HELP YOU TO EXPLORE LOTS OF DIFFERENT CAREERS AND PATHWAYS SO YOU HAVE MORE INFORMATION TO MAKE DECISIONS WHEN YOU ARE READY.
