LEARNING OUTCOMES – STUDENTS WILL:

- **UNDERSTAND WHERE THEY ARE IN THE JOURNEY TO DECIDING THEIR FUTURE CAREERS**
- **UNDERSTAND HOW TO GET CAREERS ADVICE AND SUPPORT**
- **UNDERSTAND WHAT THINGS THEY CAN DO TO DEVELOP CAREER IDEAS**

| SLIDE NUMBER | TIMINGS | KEY TEACHING POINTS |
|--------------|-----------|---|
| 1 | 1 minute | Explain that in this session students will learn how they can start exploring careers they might like to do. |
| 2 | 1 minute | It's important students understand that they do not have to have their career plans mapped out. |
| 3 | 2 minutes | There are things students can do to start understanding which careers they may be suited to. |
| 4 | 2 minutes | Getting to know themselves and the things they like and dislike is a great step to identifying careers that may interest them. |
| 5 | 2 minutes | Armed with that information students can then research different careers using the people and information around them. |
| 6 | 2 minutes | Where else may students get careers insight from? |
| 7 | 2 minutes | Knowing where to get help now and in the future is really important, so that students can always access support. |
| 8 | 2 minutes | Take the pressure off, people find their paths in lots of really interesting ways. But it's good for students to get ahead and start understanding who they are and what exciting careers are out there for them. |
