- **UNDERSTAND WHAT THE DIFFERENCES ARE BETWEEN THE PATHWAYS**
- **UNDERSTAND HOW TO EVALUATE THE PROS AND CONS OF THE PATHWAYS AVAILABLE TO THEM**

SLIDE NUMBER	TIMINGS	KEY TEACHING POINTS
1	1 minute	Explain that in this session students are going to learn about the different study and employment pathways open to them.
2	1 minute	There are a range of pathways, more and more options are opening up to students. No one pathway is better than another, it is dependent on the individual, their preferences and their career ambitions.
3	1 minute	This slide shows the pathways open at post 16 and post 18, understanding what is available and the pros and cons of each puts power into the young person's hand.
4	2 minutes	Talk through the key differences between the pathways.
5	2 minutes	Talk through the key differences between the pathways.
6	2 minutes	Talk through the key differences between the pathways.
7	2 minutes	Being informed is the best way to make decisions. Visiting places, talking to people who have chosen that pathway is a great way to boost knowledge
8	2 minutes	Students should be encouraged to understand themselves and their learning and work styles. Help them to consider these questions when looking at pathways.

Finding out more about the pathways
