Painting and Decorating

To take part in this competition you should be able to:

- Read, understand and be capable of interpreting drawing formats, in addition to receiving verbal and specification instructions
- Working & understanding measurements of (mm) millimetres
- Take dimensions from drawings and accurately measuring for marking out painting, wallpaper, stencils, frisk film & vinyl lettering placement.
- Use of various hand tools brushes for cutting-in, wet edge, flow and fine detail
- Familiar with wallcoverings pasting, hanging, cutting, alignment, pattern match
- Familiar with stencil use & placement, frisk film application & craft knife cutting
- Plan and organise your work space
- Demonstrate effective time management
- Keep the work area clean and tidy
- Working in a safe manner

You will be given a set of drawings designed to test your ability and attributes required of an individual training to be a Painter & Decorating i.e. Level 1/2

The skills required include – working from drawings, dimensional accuracy, knowledge of brush application, stencil & wallpaper techniques.

Good work practices should be adhered to at all times demonstrating good organisational skills, reading and understanding drawings and time management.

Competitors must demonstrate that they can always work in a healthy and safe manner.
