

SkillBuild Regional Qualifiers 2022 – Skill Specific Registration Rules and Guidance

This year as part of the WorldSkills UK national competition cycle, the SkillBuild national qualifier competitions have been split into Physical heats taking part across the country and Virtual Heats which can be held at the learners own provider's centre.

Registration Window: Registrations for all competitions open on the 28th February 2022 until the 1st April 2022. The link to registration is here: <https://www.worldskillsuk.org/skills/national-competitions/>

Physical Competitions: Bricklaying, Carpentry, Joinery, Painting and Decorating, Plastering, Plastering & Drywall Systems, Wall & Floor Tiling, Roof Slating & Tiling

- You can register up to 3 competitors per construction campus or training provider (not per organisation)
- You will need register your selected learners via the registration form found on the WorldSkills UK website. You will be able to register your top three learners into our competitions.
- When registering your learners, you will need to ensure that they are made aware of their registration into the competitions, as they will need to complete their part of the registration, by accepting the terms and conditions. Only once a competitor has accepted their terms and conditions, will they be considered fully registered.
- On the registration form, you will be able to select your preferred venue/date for competing. There will be a first and second choice. Once we have received your requests, competitors will be allocated to a date dependant on availability.
- You should register all of your learners to take part in the competition at the same venue/date.
- Please note, selecting a date and venue does not guarantee automatic entry to that venue/date for the regional qualifier stage.
- Once registration has closed a selection process will take place in order to determine how many competition places can be provided to each participating college per venue. Your registered competitors may need to complete an assessment to determine which competitors can take part in the competition. This selection process will be based on both the capacity of the venues and covid 19 regulations as well as your learner's assessment results.
- There are no caps on registration this year for the individual skills. However, for the numbers that we are able to take through to the national qualifiers, your competitors may be asked to complete an assessment to determine which competitors take part in the competition.
