





# PRACTICE AND PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS

Painting and Decorating

## Work from drawings to apply accurate measurements

The drawings are measured in millimetres so practice the art by marking two points and measuring in between

# Selecting the correct materials for the competition piece

Putting the right colour or wallpaper in the right place

## **Applying wallpaper**

Focus on measurements, neat cutting, butt joints, pattern match and ensure you avoid excessive paste on the surface, blisters or loose edges

# Demonstrate excellent painting skills

Look at cutting-in skills with suitable sized brushes

## **Application techniques**

Practice good brush control to leave minimal brushmarks and achieve good flow and opacity

## Measure

You may have been taught to measure in centimetres (cm), but construction measure in millimetres (mm) so be mindful

#### Work to tolerances of millimetres

Sometimes when you paint, you often paint over the pencil or chalk lines so be careful it doesn't put your setting out measurements out

## Demonstrate good housekeeping

Keep you area clean & tidy to help prevent accidents and assist speed and easier access to you work area

## Work in a safe manner

Be mindful of what you do, like working on steps and using knifes etc

# Speak to you tutor

Make sure you know what's in the tool kit and how to use it, also ensure you know everything is suitable and it works (fit for purpose)

# **Pencils**

Keep your construction marks as light as possible so they are easy to remove

## **Previous drawings**

Available from Skillbuild & Crown Paints. These will provide an idea of what's involved.
