Cabinet Making - Hand Skills



Lesson plan - 2hrs

AIM:

Developing your hand skills so as not to be too reliant on machines and power tools.

ACTIVITY:

Work through the photos with descriptors, discuss the top tips and how they might impact the practice piece, then produce the task to the best of your ability.

Suitable for

Learners undertaking: Level 2/3 qualification.

Resources needed

Skills

Attention to detail, accuracy, focus, reflection, self-belief and drive.

Learning outcomes

After completing this module, learners will be able to:

- recognise the importance of hand skills to improve their techniques and knowledge
- cut a commonly used joint without the use of machines
- understand the importance of small details that may normally be overlooked.

Section	Timings	Key teaching points
Lesson Plan	10 minutes	Introduce the topic of hand cut joints and the importance of have the skills.
		Discuss the following 'Top tips':
		 practise sawing perfectly straight and square on a spare piece of timber
		 make sure not to oversaw or undercut shoulders
		 take the mitring slowly, taking off even slightly too much will result in gaps in the joint and will not give a clean crisp result
		 be sure to cut the correct side off the mitres
		 take your time. Speed will come with practice; it's not a race. Plenty of time has been allowed for the task
		 when checking your work, always look for things being wrong rather than things being right. This will avoid overlooking issues and aid improvement.
Photos and descriptors demonstration	25 minutes	Look over the photos with descriptors demonstration and have the learners take notes, paying close attention to the top tips, potential problems and how their skills could be improved along with accuracy and speed.
Task Brief (below)	10 minutes	Familiarise learners with the task. Plan out all processes and have the tools required to hand.
Infrastructure & H&S checklist	10 minutes	Prepare for the activity by ensuring all equipment is ready to use, timber machined out and that all H&S checks are in place.
Task Completion	50 minutes	Get learners to complete the task by following the instructions on the task brief.
Marking criteria	15 minutes	Marking sheet provided to record learners' scores. Do not forget to feedback to WorldSkills UK.
