Lesson Plan - 20 minutes (Assembly & Lesson)

Learning Outcomes

- Students will learn what an interview is and the different types they may experience
- Students will learn how to prepare for an interview

SLIDE NUMBER	TIMINGS	KEY TEACHING POINTS
2	1 minute	Introduction slide.
3 & 4	3 minutes	Discuss the slides.
5	4 minutes	Get students to complete the checklist.
6	10 minutes	Get students to practice an interview situation with the interview practice questions.
7	2 minutes	Wash-up – ask students to complete the reflection sheet.
