



How to get to Rye Hill Campus





By bus

The following bus services stop close to the college on Westmorland Road and Rye Hill: numbers 1, 30, 31, 32 and 32a.

The following bus services stop close to the college on Scotswood Road: numbers 8, 21, 22, 80, 602, 604, 610, 632 and 633.

By train or Metro

Newcastle Central Station is only ten minutes' walk from Rye Hill Campus.

Turn left out of Central Station, following Neville Street and then Westmorland Road. You will pass Times Square and the Centre for Life on your left. Continue up Westmorland Road, past the Discovery Museum on your right, to the top of the hill where the road bends left. You will come directly to the campus on your left hand side.

By car

From the North or South: follow the directions to Newcastle above. As you cross the Redheugh Bridge, move into the left hand lane and turn left immediately after you have crossed the bridge. At the first roundabout turn right into the college car park. Parking is free.

From Newcastle City Centre: follow signs to Central Station, or Blaydon A695. Once past the station, bear left at the traffic lights beside the Centre for Life, go straight on at the next traffic lights and turn right at the next traffic lights into Railway Street. Follow the road round to the right and then straight on at the Scotswood Road roundabout into the college car park. Parking is free.
